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PROFILE OF THE COLLEGE

Lalit Chandra Bharali College, established on 9th August, 1971 and situated at an easily accessible location, was started at the initiative of some benevolent persons of greater Maligaon area and the generous financial help of the donor after whom the College is named. It was established to cater the needs of the students of Guwahati and its periphery in particular and the state as well as the entire N.E. region as a whole. The College is situated at the eastern boundary of the N.F Railway H.Q. and at the foot hills of the Nilachal Hills, the abode of the Mother Goddess Kamakhya. The site of the College, surrounded by the beautiful Nilachal and Adingiri Hills which once served as the Western Ghat of the Mighty Ahoms, provide an environment of peace and serenity ideal for both teaching and learning.

The College is situated about 3k.m. away from Adabari Bus Stand, 5 k.m. from the Gauhati University, 7 k.m. from the Guwahati Railway Station and is easily approachable from all sides.

The College is permanently affiliated to the Gauhati University and registered under (i) 2-F (ii) 12 B of the UGC since 1994.

The College offers undergraduate education in the three stream- Arts, Science and Commerce.

The Arts stream of the College came under the Deficit Grant in Aid System of the Govt. of Assam in September, 1983. The B.Sc. course was started in 1995, the BCA course in 2006, B.Sc.(IT) and BBA in 2008 and B.Com course in 2009. The B.Sc. course of the college came under provincialisation system in 2013. At present, the College offers education for BA, BBA, BCA, B.Sc. B.Sc. (IT), B. Com and PGDCA under GU.

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. ATTENDANCE :

Regular attendance in class is compulsory for the students. Willful absence from the class is treated as serious breach of College discipline. A student failing to attend classes for 25 days at a stretch from the date of commencement of classes shall forfeit his / her seat. Eligibility of students to appear in the Final Examinations depends upon the relevant rules of the concerned authorities.

2. IDENTITY CARD :

An Identity Card issued to every student is to be kept by him / her during College hours. Any loss or damage of Identity card must be immediately reported to the College Authority.

3. USE OF UNIFORMS :

Students will have to wear only the approved uniform inside the college campus.

4. USE OF MOBILE PHONE :

Use of Mobile Phones by students inside the College campus is strictly prohibited. Any one found using Mobile Phones inside the College Campus is severely punished.

5. RAGGING :

Ragging is strictly prohibited. Anyone found indulging in any act of Ragging will be dealt as per rules.

Ragging has been defined as :

"Any act causing, inducing, compelling or forcing a student, whether by way of practical joke or otherwise, to be any act which detracts from human dignity or violates his person or expose him to ridicule or forbear from doing any lawful act, by intimidating, wrongfully restraining, wrongly confining, or injuring him by using criminal force to him or by holding out to him any threat of such intimidation, wrongful restraint, wrongful confinement, injury or the use of criminal force."

The Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed that Ragging be banned from all educational institutions. Ragging has been made a cognizable offence and it attracts punishment of rigorous imprisonment of three years and/or a fine of Rs. 25,000/-.

6. FACILITIES :

a) Library

The Library of the college has around 19 thousand books, 30 periodicals and 10 newspapers of national and international repute. It follows open access system and introduced SOUL, a Library Management Software Package developed by INFLIBNET (Information and Library Network) Centre for library automation.

Students may borrow books from the Library against cards. They can utilize the reading room facilities. The student must follow existing rules of the Library.

Library working hours : 10.00 a.m. to 04.00 p.m.

b) Book Bank :

The College has introduced a Book Bank in the Library for helping the deserving student with Text Books and Reference Books.

c) Travel Concession :

Students are entitled to avail student concession to travel offered by different agencies as per rule.

d) College Merit Prizes :

Students securing the highest aggregate marks in TDC Final Examination (Arts & Science) are awarded Late Sabitri Bharali Award and each of them carries cash award of Rs. 5000/- and a certificate.

e) Students' Aid Fund :

The College has a Students' Aid Fund formed by the contribution of the students to help the poor meritorious students of the College. The Fund also provides assistance to meet medical expenses of students when and where required.

f) Disaster Management Cell :

The College has a Disaster Management Cell. Its objective is to create awareness among the students, teacher and the community to mitigate disasters by 'making disaster management plans. Appropriate training and knowledge are imparted about different skills and techniques to face emergent situation due to any disaster.

g) Departmental Facilities :

i) Computer Science and Information Technology : The Department has two periodically update A/C Laboratories with seating arrangements for about 100 students. The A Laboratories are networked with Central Authentication Mechanism and fully Client-Server Technology. Moreover, the Dept. has a laboratory equipped with Micro-Processor Kit.

ii) Electronics : The Dept. has a periodically updated A/C Laboratory with seating arrangement for 30 students for basic Electronics. There is a separate set-up for Digital Electronics with seating arrangement for 20 students. The Dept. has its own computational facility.

h) PHOTOSTAT FACILITY :

This facility is available for all within the College Campus.

i) MAGAZINE :

The College Magazine is published annually. The magazine provides an opportunity to express the views and creative writing facilitate the students. It is a platform for development of the literary talent of the students. The magazine is run by an Editorial Board constituted by the Principal.

j) STUDENTS RELIEF FUND :

The Fund is specially used for the students affected by different natural calamities like flood, fire, earthquake etc.

k) AUDIO-VISUAL FACILITIES :

The College uses Liquid Crystal Display (LCD) Projector and sound system as important aids for holding seminars, workshops, lectures and for teaching.

l) GENERATOR :

There is a facility of 62.5 KM Generator which can meet the demand of electric current of the whole campus during power failure.

m) CANTEEN :

The canteen facility is available within the College campus for the students, teachers and employees.

n) CAMPUS INTERVIEW :

The College holds Campus Interview for offering placement to the students. Different multinational companies like TCS, IBM, Wipro, Infosys etc. have recruited a good number of students through campus interview during the last few years.

o) HOSTEL FACILITY :

The College has a Girls' Hostel which can accommodate 40 (forty) students.

6. STUDENTS' UNION :

The Lalit Chandra Bharali College Students' Union (LCBCSU) is the General Body of the Student of the College. Its membership is compulsory for every student. Office bearers are elected annually as per the Constitution of the Students' Union.

7. INTERNAL EXAMINATION :

Regular Sessional Tests are held throughout the year and credit of these tests are carried over to the TDC Final Examinations.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND EXTENSION EDUCATION PROGRAMME

The College considers extension work as the third dimensions of instruction and regards it as important as the other two dimensions namely, teaching-learning and research. This is due to the consideration that extension activities are beneficial for inculcating a sense of dedication to social upliftment and accountability among students. The College takes up extension education with its own fund. These activities are carried out through the Extension Education Cell and other cells.

TYPES OF EXTENSION WORK :

Academic Extension Activities :

The college organises Departmental Lectures, Seminars, Workshops etc. with the involvement of existing teachers and invited experts so that interdisciplinary knowledge can transmit among the teachers and the students.

Extension Through Awareness :

Awareness of primary health, drug abuse, AIDS, Blood Donation etc. are organised by the college inside and outside the College campus.

National Service Scheme (NSS) :

The NSS is a voluntary organisation of the Student under the aegis of the Union Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports established in 1989 to inculcate social consciousness and sense of responsibility, discipline and dignity of labour among the youth. The College Unit of the NSS is vibrant with activities and takes up a number of health-education programmes each year under the guidance of the Project Officer.

National Cadet Corps (NCC) :

The NCC is a National organisation which helps in inculcating the spirit of courage, confidence, self-reliance, self-service, patriotism, faith in oneself, power of thinking and adjustment which are essential to make the youth discipline and dutiful. The College NCC Unit is attached to the 50 Assam Air Sqr. (Fly) NCC.

Suggestion Box :

Suggestion from students / parents / guardians / well wishers related to the development of the College are welcome and they may drop their Suggestions in the Suggestion Box.

Students' Feedback Form :

Students of all classes are asked to provide their comments regarding teaching / learning / evaluation (teacher-wise) through Feedback form which are analyzed by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell, The Cell subsequently takes appropriate steps for improving the quality of education.

LIST OF VARIOUS COMMITTEES

1. INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL :

There is an Internal Quality Assurance Cell which looks after the activities and performances of the students and the teachers throughout the year. The Cell also acts as quality check and monitoring mechanism of all spheres of the teaching-learning process throughout the academic session.

2. MENTORING CELL :

There is a Mentoring Cell in the College. Under the Mentor Ward system each and every student is allotted a teacher as mentor who looks after the academic as well as the personal well being to the concerned students.

3. GRIEVANCE REDRESSAL CELL :

There is a Grievance Redressal Cell in the College comprising of the Principal, the Vice-Principal and one member of the teaching staff to look after the matter of grievance and indiscipline related to students and staff of the College. Decisions of the Cell are final and obligatory.

4. DISCIPLINE CELL :

The College stresses strict discipline among the students. Any kind of unruly behaviour, discourtesy or violation of the rules and regulation of the College are treated as breach of the College discipline. Any of the following acts by a student shall be considered as major offence and invite strict disciplinary action.

- a) Habitual irregularities
- b) Resorting to ragging & violence of any kind
- c) Disobedience and indecent behavior to teacher and to the College Authority.
- d) Damaging, defacing or devaluing any College property.
- e) All types of singular / group activities leading to the disruption of the congenial atmosphere of the College.

Such cases are dealt with the strict disciplinary action.

5. POSTERING & WALL WRITING :

Postering and Writing on the walls of the College Campus & the building are strictly prohibited. All notices to be circulated by the students anywhere in the College premise shall require the approval of the Principal.

6. EXAMINATION COMMITTEE :

The Examination Committee of the College is responsible for conducting the Sessional Test and Final Examination.

7. ELECTION COMMITTEE :

There is an Election Committee to conduct the election of the L.C.B.S.U.

8: THE CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL :

The Career Guidance Cell Provides information and guidance for career advancement and placement avenues of the student of the College. The Cell organises different workshops and training programmes like Entrepreneurship Development Programme, other Training Programmes for development of various skills like Communication, Group Discussion, Interview appearing etc. for the students and holds Campus Interview for placement.
