Students' Satisfactory Survey-Analysis:

The student response on teaching learning and evaluation process collected and analyzed.

- On the question of the syllabus were covered in the class, the majority of the students (85.5%) said that syllabus was covered in the class.
- 90.6% of students reported that teachers prepared for the class. Only 9.4% denied the fact.
- 84.1% of student response that teachers' communication in the class is effective and other 15.9% denied the fact.
- Majority of the students that is 89.9% think that the internal evaluation process is fair.
- 89.9% of the students were reported that the performances in assignments are discussed with students on regular basis.
- Majority of the students that is 82.6% think that mentoring service helps in their academic achievements. Only 17.4% denied the fact.
- 88.4% of students reported that teachers inform about the expected competencies and course outcomes and program outcome. Other 11.6% denied the fact.
- 94.1% of students reported that teachers cite example while explaining concepts which is a positive acknowledgement for the teacher.
- Most of the students that is 71% of students acknowledge that teachers observe the students at personal level and identify the strength and weakness of the students and helps them to grow according to their demands and needs.
- Most of the students (84.1%) also reported that teachers encourage them in participating extracurricular activities.
- Students (52.9%) reported that they have experienced use of ICT tools in the classes.
- 89.1% students agreed that all the doubts attended in their classroom by the teacher.
- 73.2% of students think that teachers identify their weakness and strength.
- 69.6% of students were satisfied about the cleanliness of the college.
- Majority of the students that is 63% of students were satisfied with the drinking water facility provided by the college.
- 75.4% of students think that the necessary books and reference readings are sufficient In their college library, on the other hand only 24.6% students denied.
- More than half of the students i.e. 60.9% of students think that the infrastructure facilities including sports and games are sufficient in the college.
- 79% of students responded positively regarding their opportunity to discuss their examination results with respective teachers and most of the students felt satisfied with their experiences.
- Regarding academic performance of the institution, 75.4% of the students acknowledged satisfied.
- Most of the students (i.e. 13% & 75.4%) reported that they are satisfied with the overall institutional performance.

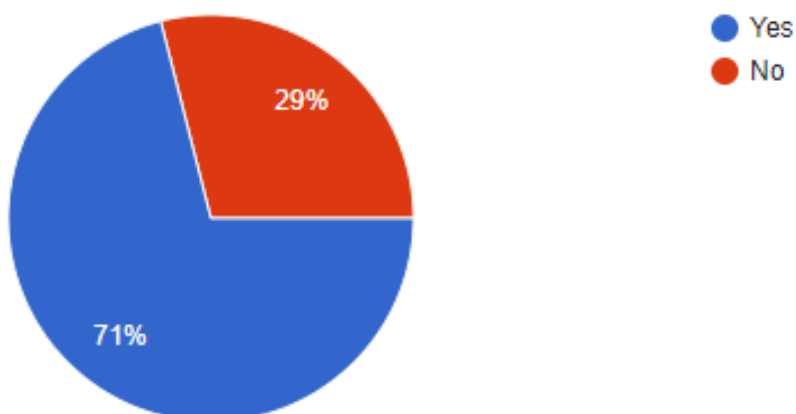

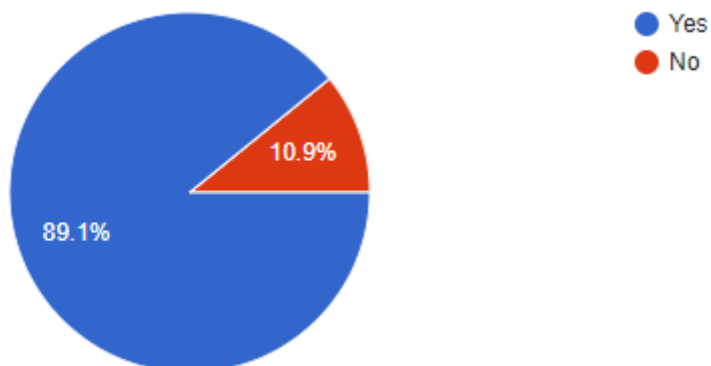
